Annual Narrative Report for 2023



Introduction

The Angels for Ukraine Charity Foundation has continued its mission to provide critical support to those affected by the ongoing full-scale invasion of Ukraine. In 2023, the foundation expanded its operations, launched new projects, and achieved significant milestones.

Key Achievements

1. Evacuation and Medical Assistance

- Successfully evacuated over 7,000 individuals from conflict zones.
- Conducted nearly 6,500 medical evacuations in collaboration with Ukraine's Ministry of Health.
- 2,060 children were evacuated from the dangerous areas, including 187 orphans.

2. Support for De-occupied Territories

Delivered humanitarian aid, including 5500 food parcels, hygiene products, and 65,000 liters of drinking water, to people in newly liberated areas in Kherson oblast.

3. Psychosocial Support Programs

- 98 psychologists who work in schools and the State Emergency Service completed the special training module.
- o Two National 5-day training events were organized for the children's psychologists.
- o One international experience exchange trip was organized to Latvia.

4. Children's Recreation and Rehabilitation

- Organized recreational and rehabilitation programs for 180 children from regions experiencing active conflict.
- More than 2,500 children were directly supported by the foundation with study kits and holiday presents.

5. Medical Facilities Support

- Three water purification systems were transferred to hospitals in Mykolaiv and Kherson oblasts.
- One Philips Bucky X-ray machine was delivered to the hospital in the city of Svitlovodsk, Kirovohrad region

6. New Initiatives

 Launched projects aimed at rebuilding infrastructure and securing international financial aid for recovery efforts of the local communities. 12 MoUs were signed with local authorities.

Financial Overview

The foundation received substantial support from private sector organizations in EU countries, Great Britain, and the USA. All funds were allocated to humanitarian projects and support for those affected by the conflict.

The foundation spent 190,493 USD and mobilized 190,582 USD in 2023.

Conclusion

The year 2023 was marked by significant challenges and achievements for the Angels for Ukraine Charity Foundation. With the support of donors and volunteers, the foundation was able to assist thousands of individuals and remains committed to its mission of aiding Ukraine.
